Divide paper into 4 and categorize the answers.

Question 2: In spite of all the good things, what are the things that make you sad in the community (threats).

Explain that the threats are like a river with crocodiles, we can keep on pulling children out and saving them. Or we can stop children from falling in the river.

"Mercy is bandaging up bloodied people in life. Justice is systemically stopping those who are blooding up people. The church needs both kinds of ministries." – Rich Villodas

Question 3: What is God's heart for your community?

Read Matthew 18:1-14

Divide the group into pairs and discuss the text – let each person give feedback about what they hear from the text.

Write all the answers on a paper. Mark themes that correlate.

Question 4: What are the developmental phases of a child's life?



Give a short overview of:

- First thousand days of life
- Pre-school (3-5 years)
- School phase (6-9)
- Pre-teen (10-12)
- Adolescence (13-18)

Commitment to ECD initiatives is a 20 year commitment!

Give a short overview of children's basic needs:

• Physical, emotional, spiritual, intellectual, social

Give a short reminder of the building blocks of ECD

• Love, security, quality nutrition and stimulation
